

Don't Break the Jar
Jeremiah 19-20:6

Jeremiah was told by God to Buy a JAR and to proclaim a MESSAGE from God. Jer. 19:1-9

An ear tingling calamity is coming because: vs. 3

1. They have forsaken God.
2. They have sacrificed to other gods.
3. They have killed the "innocent." 19:4-5

The people would be slaughtered. 19:6-7

Topheth – Jer. 7:31

The city will become a desolate reminder. 19:8

They will eat their own children during the siege. 19:9

There is an ear tingling price to be paid for sin.

The jar became symbolic of what God would do to Israel.
Jer. 19:10-15

The city and the people will be broken. 19:11-12

The leadership is singled out as offering sacrifices to the "heavenly hosts" 19:13

Jeremiah went to the Temple and proclaimed destruction on everyone. 19:14-15

Christ was broken for our sin. We must all be broken over our sin.

Jeremiah was beaten and hung in the stocks. 20:1-2

Jeremiah proclaimed that the Priest who did this would in the future be terrorized. He would eventually die in Babylon 20:3-6

Jeremiah 19-20:6

The future for those who refuse Christ is to have terror on every side.
